

DIRECTOR'S BIOGRAPHY

Pedro Pinho was born in 1977. Studied at ESTC National Film and Theatre School in Lisbon and Louis Lumière University in Paris.

In 2008 he co-directed BAB SEPTA with Frederico Lobo. This documentary is about the awaiting of those trying to enter Europe in the south border, received several prizes and was included in a short list of the 19 must-see films of 2009 by the Film Comment Magazine.

In 2012 he directed his first feature fiction film UM FIM DO MUNDO (THE END OF THE WORLD).

In 2013 he co-directed AS CIDADES E AS TROCAS (TRADING CITIES) with Luísa Homem.

He is presently working in pre-production on the upcoming TV series URB alongside other Portuguese directors João Salaviza, Leonor Noivo, Filipa Reis and João Miller Guerra.
